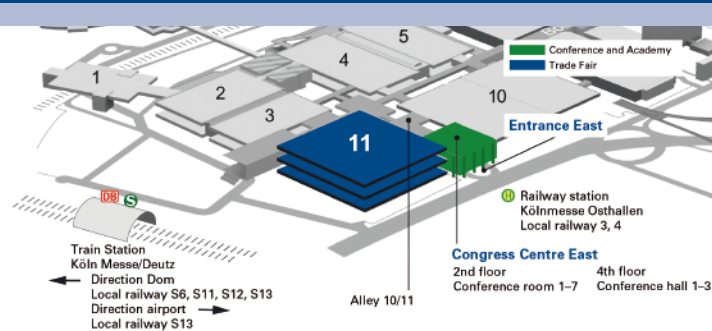

## Easy to reach from all over the world

**By air:** From Duesseldorf International Airport 30 minutes by train to exhibition centre. From International Airport Frankfurt/Main 60 minutes. Further information online.

**By car:** Directly to the exhibition centre without junctions or traffic lights. Simply follow the green signs marked "Koelnmesse". 14,500 parking spaces around the exhibition centre.

**By train:** From €99 return – throughout Germany, with the special offer of Deutsche Bahn. From Brussels 2 h, Amsterdam 2.5 h, Luxembourg 3.5 h, Paris and Basel 4 h to Cologne Messe/Deutz.

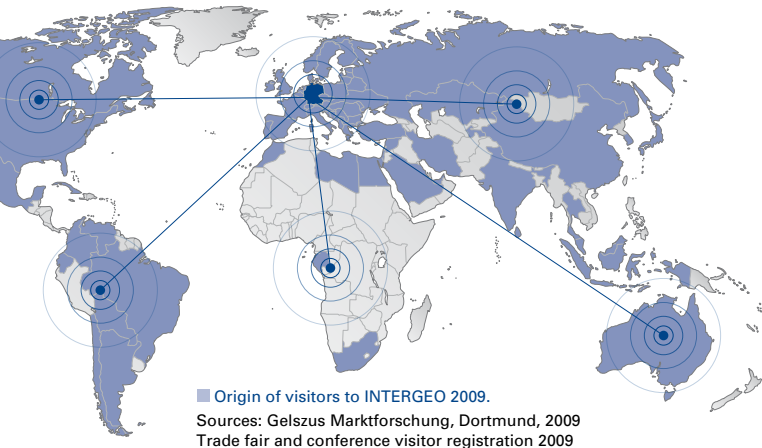
